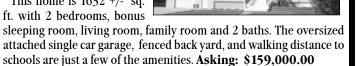

Underground Storage Tank Removals at Former Fort Peck Station, Fort Peck, Montana. The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) in conjunction with Resource Technologies, Inc. (RTI), will be closing and removing four underground storage tank (UST) systems, including tanks, fuel lines, piping, and the pump island at the Former Fort Peck Station, 301 Missouri Avenue, Fort Peck, Valley County, Montana. A DEQ representative will be onsite during the UST closure and removal.

Three 3,000-gallon UST systems and one 6,000-gallon UST system will be closed and removed. Excavation of the USTs, lines and pump island will be predominantly located on the property located at 301 Missouri Avenue but will also extend to the City of Fort Peck right-of-way, which may include streets and sidewalks. Traffic flow on Missouri Avenue in the vicinity of Fort Peck Station may be temporarily altered during the removal effort. A traffic control plan will be in place to minimize disruptions to traffic flow and to ensure the safety of the public. The tank closure and removal is expected to take approximately 5 days, and is tentatively scheduled for the week of December 9 through 13, 2013. The work will involve the use of a trackhoe, dump trucks, and related vehicles. The noise associated with the investigation will be minimal and will be conducted within normal workday hours. Petroleum odors may be noticeable but will dissipate.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN by the Board of Trustees (the "Board") of Elementary School District No. 2 (Frazer), Valley County, Montana (the "District"), that pursuant to a certain resolution duly adopted at a special meeting of the Board on October 9, 2013, a special election of the registered voters of the District will be held by mail ballot election on December 18, 2013, for the purpose of voting on the question of whether or not the Board may issue and sell general obligation school building bonds of the District in the total aggregate principal amount of Four Hundred Forty Five Thousand Dollars and No/100 (\$445,000.00) to pay a portion of the costs of repairing, restoring and replacing certain of the District buildings, including: replacing exterior finishes and siding on the staff housing building; demolition of the existing superintendent housing and design, construction and equipping of replacement superintendent housing; repair and replacement of a portion of the Frazer school building roof; related improvements; and paying costs associated with the sale and issuance of the bonds (collectively, the "Project"). The bonds shall bear interest at a rate or rates to be determined by the Board at the time of sale and be payable semiannually during a term of not more than fifteen 15) years and redeemable on any date after one-half the term.
