1. On March 19, 2015, the Department of Environmental Quality (Department) received an application for an air quality operating permit from Northern Border Pipeline. The application was given number OP2974-12. The permittee's address is 13710 FNB Parkway, Suite 300, Omaha, NE 68154-5200. The facility location is NE¼ of the NE¼ of Section 6, Township 28 North, Range 57 East, Roosevelt County.

2. The draft operating permit required by ARM Title 17, Chapter 8, Subchapter 12, Operating Permit Program will be issued to the applicant on April 6, 2016.

3. The operating permit will allow for the operation of the Northern Border Pipeline Natural Gas Compressor Station No. 3 which includes a 38,000 horsepower turbine and backup generator engine.

4. Any member of the public desiring to comment must submit their comments to the Department at the Department of Environmental Quality, Permitting and Compliance Division, Attn. Air Quality Permitting Supervisor, P.O. Box 200901, Helena, Montana 59620-0901. Comments may address the draft permit or information submitted by the applicant. In order to be considered, the comments must be received within the 30-day public comment period which is from April 6, 2016, to May 6, 2016. Copies of the application and the draft operating permit may be inspected at the Department's office in Helena. Contact the permit writer, Shawn Juers, at (406) 444-2049, or the Department Branch Office nearest the source, with specific questions relating to this draft operating permit.

5. Any member of the public desiring to request a public hearing must submit a written request to the Department at the above address. The request must be received within the 30-day public comment period.

6. The Department intends to issue the proposed operating permit after the comment period has expired and after any public hearing which might occur. A copy of the proposed operating permit may be obtained at the above address. After the 45-day EPA review period, the Department intends to issue a decision on the operating permit. The permit does not become final and effective until 30 days after the decision is issued by the Department. A copy of the final operating permit may be obtained at the above address.

7. Any person jointly or severally adversely affected by the Department decision may request a hearing appealing the operating permit before the Montana Board of Environmental Review. Any appeal must be filed within 30 days after the Department issues the decision. The request for a hearing shall contain an affidavit setting forth the grounds for the request and shall be submitted in triplicate to: Chairman, Board of Environmental Review, P.O. Box 200901, Helena, Montana 59620. Any hearing will be held under the provisions of the Montana Administrative Procedures Act.

The Valley County Weed District (VCWD), is accepting formal bids for spraying of noxious weeds on Bureau of Land Management (BLM) and Grazing District land owners' private land. A valid Montana Commercial Applicator's License issued by the MT Department of Agriculture is required. Sites and location access will be determined by VCWD and the Glasgow BLM office.

Interested bidders shall bid an hourly rate for spraying noxious weeds. Bids must be submitted to Valley County Commissioner's office by the 15th of April, 2016. The Bids will be opened on Monday at 11:30 AM the 18th of April, 2016.

The hourly bid rate shall include all cost of equipment, labor, fuel, transportation etc. Bidders are expected to honor the hourly rate for the entire 2016 spray season. Bidders must also enclose with the bid, proof of commercial general liability insurance for property damage, bodily injury or death to any one person and proof of independent contractor's license.
